Draft Work Plan for Strengthening Institutional and Policy Framework on DRR and CCA Integration Group Work Sheet: Cambodia

1. Objective

To significantly reduce disaster risk and increase resiliency by integrating DRR and CCA through the following joint activities and knowledge sharing on DRR and CCA among ASEAN members states.

- Raising public awareness of DRR and CCA
- Creating regional funding mechanism for integration of DRR and CCA
- Building capacity to strengthen institutional and policy framework on DRR and CC through the regional training opportunities;
- Establishing an ASEAN cross-sectoral collaboration mechanism to develop recommendations on the policy and implementation of DRR and CCA at the national and regional levels; and
- Sharing good practices including data sharing platform among ASEAM member states

5. Implementation structure

a. Working Group on Prevention and Mitigation

The WG on P&M is responsible for:

- Compilation and procession of the Information and knowledge collected from the Member States, sharing it among them and reporting it to the ACDM Meeting;
- Coordination and facilitation of mutual cooperation activities among the Member
 States by referring to their annual reviews and by using local resources; and
- Sharing regional needs for DRR and CCA integration with development partners and developing regional programmes with them.
- Fund Raising on DRR and CCA integration
- Introducing of New Technologies
- Data Management
- Regional Training Programme

b. ACDM National Focal Point

Each ACDM National Focal Point collects relevant information listed in Table 1 from line agencies, reviews it and reports it to the WG on P&M annually with particular focuses on:

- Monitoring of Implementation of Inregration of DRR and CCA under Current NSDP 2014-2018
- Progress of Formulation of New NSDP 2019-2023
- Progress of Disseminating and Enforcement of Disaster Management Law 2015
- Exploring Possibilities of Consolidated Climate Change Law
- Researach on Possible Collaboration between NCCC and NCDM
- Orgnazational Structure of Disaster Management
- Monitoing of Use of DRR-related Expenditure of Each Line Ministry, if possible
- Sharing Disaster Database, Hydro-met Data, Hazard and Risk Maps and their Technologies
- Enforcement of Early Waning System
- Reporting on Formulation of Guidelines and Standards
